

ORDINANCE NO. 5787

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FGC SEC. 78-438, STANDING IN TRUCK CURB LOADING ZONE; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the current ordinance governing the use of designated loading zones provides that only commercial vehicles may use these zones during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no appreciable drop in commercial vehicle traffic in the late afternoon; and

WHEREAS, loading zone space for commercial vehicles is needed during the times currently indicated on signs marking the loading zone;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Fairbanks General Code Chapter 78, Article XII, Sec. 78-438 is hereby amended as follows (new text in **underlined bold** font, deleted text in ~~strikeout~~ font):

Sec. 78-438. Standing in truck curb loading zone.

No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle for any purpose or length of time other than for the expeditious unloading and delivery or pickup and loading of materials in any place marked as a loading zone during hours when the provisions applicable to such zones are in effect. In no case shall the stop for loading and unloading of materials exceed 30 minutes. ~~From 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.~~ **It shall be unlawful to stop, stand or park in a loading zone any vehicle which is not used in a commercial trade or business and which does not bear a sign indicating it is so used during the times indicated on the signs marking the loading zone.**


Section 2. That the effective date of this Ordinance shall be the 26 day of September, 2009.


