

ORDINANCE NO. 5809

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND FGC SEC. 46-77. USE OF SNARES AND TRAPS, TO ADDRESS LIVE TRAPS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANKS, ALASKA, HEREBY ENACTS the following:

SECTION 1. That Fairbanks General Code Chapter 46, Article III, Sec. 46-77 is hereby amended as follows (new text in **underlined bold** font, deleted text in ~~strikeout~~ font):

Sec. 46-77. Use of Snares and traps.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to set a snare, **live** or steel jaw trap in any exterior place or property, whether privately or publicly owned, within the city limits; except that an administrative waiver may be issued by the mayor when it is deemed to be in the public's interest and sufficient safeguards are imposed to prevent injury to any person or property.

(b) "To set" means to place a snare, **live trap**, or open, lock and place a steel jaw trap for the purpose of snaring, trapping or injuring any wildlife, domesticated animals or humans. This does not include display of such snares or traps for the purpose of sale.
