A RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE ALASKA "SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM" TO PRODUCE A WALKING AND BIKING CONDITION ASSESSMENT AND TO DEVELOP A SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM


WHEREAS, the City of Fairbanks supports the activities of the Fairbanks Metropolitan Area Transportation System (FMATS); and

WHEREAS, the FMATS wishes to request funds to produce a Walking and Biking Condition Assessment for schools within its boundary and to develop a comprehensive Safe Routes to School Program; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Safe Routes to School would provide federal funds to help address planning, design and construction improvements in the vicinity of schools without a local funding match requirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the Mayor is authorized to apply for, execute any required documents, and accept a grant of \$100,000.00 through Alaska Safe Routes to School to produce a walking and biking condition assessment and Safe Routes to School program.


